

PRE-ACCESS DIPLOMA IN HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE PROFESSIONS, LEVEL 2

OVERVIEW

The Pre Access programme is designed for adults who wish to return to education and who currently do not hold GCSE Maths and English Grade A-C.

The course is suitable for learners who wish to progress on to the Level 3 Access Programme and who have a keen interest in health and science based careers. The programme has a range of modules, including Psychology, Sociology, Criminology and Human Physiology all of which are taught by subject specialists.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

English and maths abilities will be measured using a short online assessment prior to being offered a place on the programme.

ASSESSMENT

Assessments are varied and can include written assignments, reports, presentations, posters and portfolio building.

There are no external exams attached to the programme.
