

PAEDIATRIC FIRST AID

OVERVIEW

Would you like to feel more confident when managing first aid for your child/grandchild or children you care for? Have you a knowledge of first aid but ask whether this is still relevant when dealing with young children? Perhaps your current employment involves spending some of your time with children and you are unsure how to respond to an accident or illness. This 8 hour course will give you the basics of how to deal with common childhood accidents and illnesses.

An introduction to the treatment of burns.

How to recognise a sprain, strain or fracture.
